09:00 - 10:00 Okayama Castle

11:20 – 12:10 Kibitsu Shrine

Kibitsu-jinja Shrine is a shrine located in Okayama. In the famous Japanese fairytale "Momotaro" there is a deity named Kibitsu-hiko-no-mikoto, and that deity is enshrined here. The establishment date is unknown but it is known that the main hall has been destroyed by fire at least twice in the past and the present main hall was rebuilt in 1425.



12:50 – 14:00 Lunch at JF Okayama Ryoren

14:10 – 14:40 Washuzan Observatory (overlook Seto Ohashi Bridge)

Mt. Washuzan offers visitors a view of the quintessential scenery of the Setonaikai National Park, known as Japan's first national park. The park is a recommended site for viewing the Great Seto Bridge, newly listed in the Michelin Green Guide Japan as the longest two-tiered bridge system in the world.



15:25 – 17:00 Kurashiki Historical District

With its many cultural facilities—including the Ohara Museum of Art and its collection of international masterpieces; the red-bricked Kurashiki Ivy Square, a reproduction of the textile factory once representative of Kurashiki, built on the site of the former factory; the Kurashiki Museum of Folkcraft, boasting a collection with some 700 handicrafts; and the Kurashiki Archeological Museum—Kurashiki Bikan Historical Quarter offers visitors a taste of Western influence harmonized with Japanese style.
