Born in Singapore, Grand Master Tan inherited his forefathers' expertise at the age of 30 and established Way Chinese Geomancy Centre in 1984. He is a veteran of geomancy studies and has provided excellent fengshui consultancy services for over 40 years.

Having conducted more than 1000 seminars worldwide, GM Tan is well-known internationally but amid his success, he remained an avid pupil who continually enhances his practice with research and studies.

Since 2004, GM Tan has been representing Singapore in the International Feng Shui Convention (IFSC). In 2008, he received the prestigious title of "Feng Shui Grand Master" by the International Feng Shui Association (IFSA) and is the first feng shui practitioner in Singapore to be awarded this title.
